GARBAGE PICKUP

CURBSIDE PICKUP

MONDAYS & THURSDAYS

NO HOLIDAY GARBAGE PICKUP ON MAY 30, SEPTEMBER 5, NOVEMBER 24.

MONDAYS—Regular household garbage

THURSDAY—Regular household garbage, plus Junk (furniture, household items, etc.)

Both days Curbside pickup only.

To schedule an appointment call Miele Sanitation at 201-768-3818 for pick-up of large appliances, household equipment, screens, refrigerators, air conditioners and ice makers with freon removed before hand by a certified service person. (If you are buying a new appliance, check with the merchant whether he will remove and dispose of your old appliance.)

RECYCLING PICKUP

1st and 3rd Wednesdays—Curbside pickup of comingled recyclable containers

Containers must be **clean and empty**. Place containers in a trash can or larger container, not in paper or plastic bags.

All recycling symbols accepted (1-7).

Glass bottles, jars and containers. All colors. Lids and caps on or off. Waxed paper cartons that contained liquid, milk, juice, sports drinks, broth, soup, juice boxes and frozen food cartons. Clear, colored or black plastic bottles, containers, food-to-go containers, muffin, cookie and cake containers. Household cleaning wipe and baby wipe containers. Glass or plastic soda, water, milk, alcoholic and non-alcoholic beverage containers. Soap, shampoo, conditioner, detergent bottles from bathroom and laundry room. Clean, dry paint cans with lids off. Tin, steel, bimetal and aluminum food containers like coffee cans, beverage cans, soup and pet food containers, empty aerosol cans, etc.

Clean aluminum foil pie plates, cooking trays and pans. Yogurt, mayonnaise, cheese, peanut butter, ketchup and mustard containers, etc. Empty cooking oil, butter and margarine plastic or metal containers.

ITEMS NOT RECYCLED

Place boxes with residue in regular garbage.

No used paper plates, paper cups or paper towels.

No Styrofoam, plastic bags, plastic shopping bags.

No plastic knives, forks, spoons or dishes.

No ceramic, pottery, crystal, cups, plates or glasses, flower pots, garden hoses. No windows, plate glass, mirror glass or light bulbs. No meat trays.

Do not recycle automotive use containers such as anti-freeze jugs or motor oil bottles.

2nd and 4th Wednesdays—Curbside pickup of newsprint, magazines, catalogs, junk mail, office and computer paper, paper bags, telephone books, cardboard and cereal type boxes tied in bundles not to exceed 12", placed in brown paper bags or usable containers. Corrugated boxes are recyclable; do not put out for garbage as they will not be taken.

THERE ARE NO RECYCLING PICKUPS ON THE FIFTH WEDNESDAY OF THE MONTH

GRASS COLLECTION—Only MONDAYS from April 4 through October 24 **CURBSIDE** must be placed in **UNCOVERED REUSABLE 30 GALLON CONTAINERS**. Grass in bags **WILL NOT** be picked up.

OTHER RECYCLING INFORMATION

BRANCHES & LIMBS—Branches must be placed curbside, not in the street, in neat piles all facing the same way.

BAGGED LEAVES placed at curbside will be picked up, absolutely no garbage in bags! Bags with leaves and garbage will not be picked up. Last day you may put out bags is May 9.

Building and construction materials **WILL NOT** be collected. Private arrangements must be made for disposal.
